PRESENT-DAY PHOTOS SOUGHT TO CELEBRATE CARMEL CENTENNIAL FOR CONSIDERATION FOR CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA FOR 2066 TIME CAPSULE

The 100 Photos Project Committee is requesting present-day photographs of Carmel-by-the-Sea for potential inclusion in the time capsule to be buried at the beginning of 2017 and opened in either 50 or 100 years (still to be determined). From a notable fence to the scenic coastline, the committee will be looking for photographs that depict Carmel's uniqueness and all that is remarkable about the town, which this year celebrates its Centennial.

The committee will ultimately select approximately 100 current photographs of Carmel-by-the-Sea from different entrants (open to the public) to be part of the time capsule. For consideration, the photographs—color or black and white—should be from 2016, unmounted and 4 x 6 inches in size.

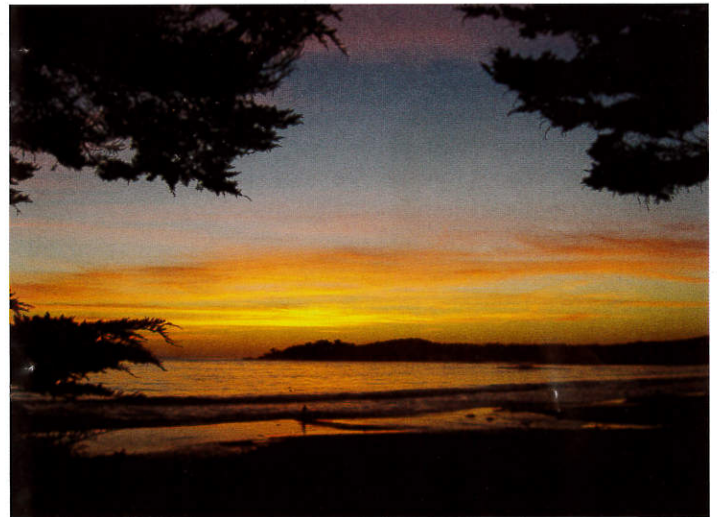
Photographs will be collected through December and may be submitted at one of the drop boxes located at the circulation desks at either Harrison or the Park branch library, and at City Hall. Requested but not required is a description of the photo and the name and age of the photographer on the back of the photo. Special writing pencils will be provided at the drop box locations to ensure the writing won't damage other images submitted.

The photographs will be scanned at the library's history department before being properly sealed for inclusion in the time capsule. Every effort will be made to include all submitted photographs (only one per person, please) but space in the capsule may limit the number to 100.

The 100 Photos Project committee reserves the right to make the final decision on the photographs selected. Judges, to be determined if necessary, will place the emphasis on "variety" as the images are intended to tell a wide-ranging story of Carmel-by-the-Sea from 2016.

There is no cost to submit, and entrants should note that unused photographs will not be returned.
